

Lawrence Kansas July 9th 1872

The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners O. Darling chairman of the board W. B. Diabro and Joel Crover, and Paul R. Brooks

The following proceedings were had

In the matter of the petition of
J. H. Haight and others for
the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road, the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of the viewers together with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of H.
A. Wittich and others for the
alteration of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the change of road prayed for in the petition, the report was this day publicly read, and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said change of road as located and surveyed, will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers together with the plat and survey be recorded and that said change of road be established. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper overseer of roads to cause said road as changed to be opened for public travel.
