It is Ordered that the petition be dismissed without further proceedings at the cost of the petitioners.

In the matter of the petition of J. M. Shively and others for the vacation of a portion of the road established on the petition of S. A. Halderman and others April 6 One thousand eight hundred twenty one

The jurors having reported in favor of vacating said portion of road the report was this day publicly read the board being of opinion that said road is necessary and required by the public convenience It is Ordered by the board that the petition be dismissed without further proceedings and that the petitioners pay the costs and expenses of their application.

In the matter of the petition of E. A. Taylor and others for the vacation of a county road.

The jurors having failed to agree upon a report and Mrs. Cutchfield one of the jurors having made a report against the vacation of said road and Henry Brown one of the jurors having made a report in favor of the vacation of said road the two reports were read, and the board being of opinion that said road is of no public utility it is ordered that the same be vacated as follows Beginning at a point Twenty five (25) feet North of the South East Corner of Section Sixteen (16) Town Twelve (12)
