Darling Surveyor of said road alteration, and that they meet at the house of John Shepherd on the 8th day of August A.D. 1872 at ten o'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary Order to said viewers and Surveyor.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows commencing at the North end of Bridge Street Lawrence where said street intersects the South line of Section nineteen (19) Town Twelve (12) Range Twenty (20) and running thence in a Northerly direction parallel with the track of the K. P. R. R. track, a distance of about 160 rods to the half section line East and West of section nineteen (19) Township Twelve (12) Range Twenty (20), and running thence East about Twenty (20) rods to Center of said section nineteen (19) Town Twelve (12) Range Twenty (20). Where it will intersect with a state road leading from Lawrence to Oskaloosa. and A. G. Norman one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two Hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition had been given as required by law.
