

Section ten (10) town thirteen (13) South, Range twenty one (21) East. Thence South on half section line one mile, to intersect an East and West road, and Jacob Rehn one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that J. Gilmore J. Garvin and William Hughes three disinterested householders of the county of Douglas be and they are hereby appointed viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor of said road and that they meet on the twelfth day of August 1872 at the place of beginning of said proposed road and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their respective appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary Order to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Paul W. Rote and others for the establishment of a county road.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the North East corner of Section Seventeen (17) Township thirteen (13) range twenty one (21) thence West on Section line three quarters of a mile to intersect an established road, and Paul W. Rote one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is Ordered that L. J. Sperry, J. J. McHugh and William Hughes be and they are hereby appointed viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the place of beginning of said proposed road designated
