In the matter of the petition of
N. P. Deming and others for the
alteration of a county road.

The petitioners having made application for a change of road in words and figures as follows to wit: To the honorable the Board of county commissioners of the County of Douglas Kansas The undersigned your petitioners respectfully represent that the public convenience requires that a road be located and established along the following described route to wit: Beginning at a point about twenty rods South of the North West corner of Section 1, Town 13 range 19 Thence East about 20 rods Thence North to section line between Sections 1 and 36 Thence East to a point 11⁵⁰ chains East of the South West corner of Section 36 Thence Northwardly 80 rods Thence East to intersect a road established January 12 1867. Your petitioners further represent that a part of the road established by the Board of commissioners of Douglas County January 12 1867 on the petition of J. S. Brown and others ought to be vacated as a Public Highway to wit: Beginning at a point 11⁵⁰ chains East of the S.W. corner of Section 36, Town 12, range 19 Thence vacate said road to a point 16⁷⁵ chains West of the North East corner of the South East 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of said Section 36 Your petitioners therefore ask, that such proceedings may be had to locate said road and to vacate said part of road as may be authorized and directed by law. And N. P. Deming one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law.
