Harrison on the 29th day of August 1872 at ten o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of their ^{duties of their} several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

establishment of a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the Santa Fe road on the half section line of Section one (1) township fifteen (15) range twenty (20) thence North to the South line of Section thirteen (13) town fourteen (14) Range twenty (20) thence East on said line to section fourteen (14) where it will intersect the road running West to the road leading from Baldwin city to Lawrence, and H. B. Nyckoff one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is Ordered that Levi Woodward, John C. Campbell and C. M. Lewis three disinterested house holders of the county of Douglas be and they are hereby appointed viewers, and S. C. Darling Surveyor
