

said Railroad company have requested that the bonds be deposited in escrow with Bartholow, Lewis & Co of Saint Louis, Missouri instead of the said Farmers Loan and Trust company. It is therefore Ordered that the bonds to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars prepared to be issued in payment of said subscription of stock to the Saint Louis, Leavenworth and Denver Railroad be placed in escrow with Bartholow, Lewis & Co of Saint Louis, Missouri to be delivered to said company only upon the certificate of the County Commissioners of the county of Douglas, that the terms and conditions upon which such subscription was made and said bonds were to be issued and not until coupons to the amount of the interest accrued at the time of such delivery shall have been detached from the said bonds.
