

Lawrence Kansas September 2 1892

The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to law at the office of the county clerk. There were present commissioners O. Darling (chairman), Joel Groen and H. B. Distrow, and Paul R. Brooks county clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

The board proceeded to estimate and determine the amount of money to be raised for county purposes and also for interest on outstanding bonds with the following result

Ordered that a tax of four and a half mills on the dollar be levied on all the taxable property of the county for general purposes, and that a tax of four mills on the dollar on all the taxable property of the county for interest on outstanding bonds, and that a road tax of three mills on the dollar be levied on all the taxable property of the county except incorporated cities.

Ordered that a tax of two mills on the dollar be levied on all the taxable property in the township of Cudora for township purposes the trustee having failed to levy a tax.

Ordered that a tax of two mills on the dollar be levied on all the taxable property in the township of Cudora for interest and sinking fund on account of Rail road bonds issued.
