establishment of said proposed road. It is Ordered that
the petition be dismissed at the cost of the petitioners
without further proceedings.

In the matter of the petition
of G. M. Blayney and others
for the establishment of a road.

The report of the viewers
having been read at the July session of the board and
action thereon postponed, the report was again read, and
the viewers having made a separate report in writing of
the amount of compensation and damages which they
have awarded to land owners by reason of the location
of said road through their several premises, said report
was also publicly read. And the board being of opinion that
the compensation awarded by said viewers to wit: To J.
Howell seventy-five Dollars, is reasonable and just, that said
road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance
to justify the payment of said compensation out of the county
treasury: no legal objection being made, It is ordered that the
county clerk issue an order on the county treasurer for the
amount so awarded in favor of J. Howell. That the several
reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said
road be recorded and that said road be established as
public highway. It is further Ordered that the county clerk
issue an order in the name of the board an order to the
proper owners of roads, directing them to cause said road
to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of
Alfred Deppe and others for
the establishment of a road.
