

a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises. Said report was also read. And the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said surveyors to the several claimants be as follows:

To D. G. Kennedy Thirty five dollars compensation and Forty dollars damages.

To J. P. Bell Thirty Dollars compensation and Forty dollars damages.

To S. B. Wyckoff Thirty five dollars compensation, and Forty dollars damages, is excessive. It is Ordered that compensation be awarded and allowed to said claimants as follows:

D. G. Kennedy Twenty Dollars. J. P. Bell Twenty Dollars. and S. B. Wyckoff Twenty Dollars. and that no damages be allowed. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue, ~~order~~ upon the county treasurer for the amount so allowed. And no legal objections being made It is Ordered that the several reports of the surveyors with the survey and that be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue, in the name of the board, an Order to the proper Overseers of roads, directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petitions of J. Rehn and others for the establishment of a road

The surveyors having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and said surveyors having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to the land owners by reason of the location of said land through their several premises, said report was also publicly read. And the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said surveyors be as follows:

To Charles Lotholz Twenty five dollars compensation

" Joseph Sennald Fifteen dollars compensation

" Mary Knustler Fifty Dollars compensation

" Lawrence Elder Twenty five dollars compensation
