The said petitioners having made application for the alteration of the Topeka and Clinton State road as follows commencing at a point where said road now crosses the East line of Section Eleven (11) Town thirteen (13) Range Seventeen (17) Thence South on said line to the South West corner of the North West quarter of Section thirteen (13) in said town and range. Thence East on the quarter section line to the West line of Section Seventeen (17) or as near to said quarter section line as practicable and C. C. Scofield one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas. Conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law It is ordered that R. S. Scouton, J. L. Jones and William Brown be and they are hereby appointed viewers and C. C. Darling Surveyor of said proposed alteration
