

also read and the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said referees court Quincan & Hornsby Seventy five dollars compensation and Seventy five Dollars damages is excessive but that said Quincan and Hornsby ought to be allowed reasonable compensation and damage. It is Ordered that the sum of Seventy five Dollars be allowed for compensation and Seventy five dollars for damages and that the clerk draw an Order on the County Treasurer for the amount so allowed and it is further Ordered that the reports plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue, in the name of the board an order to the proper Owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.

the vacation of a road

The referees having reported in favor of the vacation of said road and the board being of opinion that said road is of no public utility It is Ordered that a portion of the road established January 1867 on the petition of J. S. Brown and others & wit: Beginning at a point 11⁵⁰ chains East of the South West corner of Section thirty six (36) Town Twelve (12) Range Nineteen thence to a point 16⁷⁵ chains West of the North East corner of the South East quarter of the S. West quarter of said section 36 do and the same is hereby vacated.

for the establishment of a road

The referees having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day read and on motion Ordered that action on the report be postponed until the April meeting of the board 1873
