

In the matter of the petition of
 E. L. Hyckoff and others for
 the vacation of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the vacation of a road on the township line between Range twenty (20) and twenty one (21) Township fourteen (14) & 15: from the North East corner of Section thirty six (36) Town fourteen (14) Range twenty (20) & the South East corner of said section and E. L. Hyckoff one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two Hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas. Conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. which bond is accepted and approved. and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law It is Ordered that James Skaggs, Thomas M. Hall and L. O. Single be and they are hereby appointed viewers and S. C. Darling Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 6th day of February 1873 at 2 O'clock P.M. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary Order to said viewers and Surveyors

In the matter of the petition of
 Loan Lehartrand and others for
 the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South West corner of the North East quarter of Section ten (10) Township fourteen (14) range eighteen (18) Thence East on said line to where it intersects a road running North and South on Washington creek thence to follow said road in a South Easterly direction to a point about One hundred and eight (108) rods South of said line. Thence East as near as practicable about One hundred and forty rods. Thence North about thirty (30) rods. Thence East to the East line of the South West quarter of Section twelve (12) Thence South on said line about thirty (30) rods thence to the East.
