It is Ordered that the County Clerk issue an Order on the County Treasurer for the said amount of \$531.20 payable to said James Blood January tenth 1874 with interest

In the matter of the petition of Thomas H. Tail to have tax sale orders 17, 19, & 21 Ohio Street & Lots 50, 52 & 54 Louisiana Street Lawrence set aside.

Said petitioners having made application to have the sale for taxes of lots 17, 19 and 21 Ohio Street and lots 50, 52 and 54 Louisiana Street set aside on account of illegality the board being of opinion that the sale of said lots for taxes for the year 1871 was illegal. It is Ordered that the County Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to receive from the said Tail the amount for which said lots were sold without interest and receipt for the taxes of the year 1871 on said lots and that the Treasurer cancel the sale for taxes of said lots on the tax sale record.

The County Clerk presented County warrants on the Treasurer to the amount of two hundred and thirty and 7/100 Dollars that had remained uncashed for some years. The Orders were examined with the original record and On Motion Ordered that a list be made and filed in the Clerk's office and that said warrants be cancelled and destroyed.
