The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to call of the chairman. There were present Commissioners A. Darling, Joel Groves & H. B. Dugrow and Paul R. Brooke County clerk.

The following proceedings were had in the matter of a county road established in 1862 the true course of which has become uncertain.

It having been shown to the satisfaction of the board that the route of a road established in the year 1862 beginning at the N. W. corner of the N. E. 1/4 of Section 31 township 12 range 18 thence South to intersect the Clinton road has become uncertain on account of the destruction of the records of the county clerk's office by fire in the year 1863. It is therefore Ordered that Richard Scanton, George Roller and Valentine Roller be and they are hereby appointed to review said road and for that purpose shall meet with the county surveyor on Saturday the third day of May at ten o'clock A.M. at the German Church in Hamvada Township, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of their several appointments as required by law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary Order to said Viewers and Surveyor.

Ordered, that after this date no bill for goods furnished farmers will be acted upon except fully itemized accounts with certificate of Orenum of proof of the proper township that the bill is correct and furnished on his order, and further that no account will be audited for articles not enumerated in the following list.
