

Bills, Soda, Soap, Potatoes, Doughnut meal, flour in limited quantities, not to exceed in price \$3.50 per hundred and further that physicians bill will be considered unless accompanied by certificate of Overseer that the services were rendered by their direction. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk furnish each Overseer with a copy of this Order.

Ordered that the sum of \$30. be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general county fund for the support of the family of Mrs. [] for one year said appropriation payable to the Overseer of Poor LeCompton Township.

Ordered that the sum of \$50. be and the same is hereby appropriated for temporary support of Poor in Euclid Township appropriation payable to and to be expended by and accounted for by the Overseer of Poor of said Township.

The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas Kansas met pursuant to call of the chairman.

There were present Commissioners Darling, Croves, DeBrow and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

Ordered that the county Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay the interest on the bonds issued to the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver R.R. Co. accruing July 1 1873 and for that purpose to borrow money upon the credit of the county at a rate of interest not to exceed 12 per cent per annum and further that said Treasurer be authorized to pay the coupons already due on said bonds out of any funds in the County Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
