The report of the viewers having been read at the April session of the board and action thereon postponed until the July session of the board the report was again read, a separate report in writing having been filed by said viewers of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read. And the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said viewers to the several claimants to wit: Michael Dyer Twenty five dollars (\$25) Compensation. D. A. Munger Sixty Dollars (\$60) damages. Conrad Truesheim Forty five dollars, damages H. P. Arvill Twenty five dollars (\$25) damages R. H. Pearson Forty five dollars (\$45) damages is not reasonable and just.
