for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises. said report was also publicly read. and the board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by the viewers to Mrs Anna Cook to wit: Seventy five dollars (\$75) is reasonable and just and also that D. C. Kalburt a claimant before the viewers but who was awarded nothing is entitled to compensation to the amount of Fifty dollars, that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the county treasury. It is ordered that the County clerk draw orders upon the County Treasurer in favor of said claimants for the amounts so allowed and that the several reports with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper officers of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.

Fred Leokhill and others for the
vacation of a part of the town
site of Prairie City, Kansas.

Said petitioners having made application for the vacation of a part of the town site of Prairie City and it appearing from the affidavit of said petitioners filed with said petition that they were the owners of a majority of the lots or subdivisions of the portion of said town site proposed to be vacated. It is ordered that the County Clerk advertise ^{in the name of the board} as required by law that the board will take testimony in regard to the occupancy of the lands described in the petition on the first day of September ad 1878.
