Petition of J. H. Ransom and others for alteration of roads. (see page 203).

To the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. We the undersigned citizens of Clinton Township Douglas County, Kansas would respectfully petition your honorable board to establish a road and vacate as follows. Commencing at First Street at the South West corner of 100th Number Three (3) Block No 8 in the town of Clinton. Thence North to intersect the Leecompton and Clinton road on Section line between Sections 14 and 15 T. 13. R. 15 also commence at a point about fifty five (55) rods North of the North line of the town of Clinton on section line above described, thence North East about sixty five (65) rods to the Clinton depot on the Lawrence and South Western Rail road. Thence West along the South side of said L. & S. W. R. R. to a point opposite the Ransom ford, or to intersect the Leecompton and Clinton road. We would also ask to have that part of the said Leecompton and Clinton road, vacated from the intersection of said road and L. & S. W. R. R. to a point at or near the center of the S. E. of the N. E. one quarter of Section 15 T. 13 R. 15. We would further ask to have a road commence at the point last named thence North to the said road along the side of the L. and S. W. R. R. aforesaid. We would also ask to have that part of the said Leecompton and Clinton road lying North and East of the East end half (1/2) of Block No 8 in the town of Clinton vacated.

The board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
