The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment there were present Darling, Groves and Disbrow and Paul R. Brooks county clerk. The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the petition
of James Walton and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the road the petition was this day publicly read and no objection being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that the said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is Ordered that the reports of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to the proper Overseer of roads directing that said road be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petition
of Henry Mohler and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and no legal objection being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is Ordered that the report of the viewers, with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseer of roads, directing that said road be opened according to law.
