

range eighteen (18) on the road leading from Leecompton to Big Springs, thence running due South as near as may be until it strikes the California road (so called). And R. H. Duncan one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved.

and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, it is Ordered, that J. L. Jones, J. B. Heil and William Brass, three disinterested householders of said county, be and they are hereby appointed viewers and S. C. Darling surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition, on the 31st day of October 1873 at ten o'clock A.M. or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board, the necessary Order to said viewers and surveyor.

The said petitioners having made application for the review of the road known as the "Leecompton and Big Springs road" beginning at Leecompton, thence West on township line to the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section six (6) Township Twelve (12) range eighteen (18) thence as now travelled to a point nearly opposite the house of Mr Hogg thence South West on the old survey until it strikes the road as now travelled, thence due South to the California road. And it appearing that the route of said road has become uncertain, on account of the destruction of the records of the County Clerk's office, It is Ordered that J. L. Jones A. H. Paxon and A. S. Pickew, three disinterested householders of said county be and they are hereby appointed a committee of reviewers and S. C. Darling surveyor and that they meet at the place of beginning of said road on the twelfth day of November 1873 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.
