Street.} Also so much of Seventh Street as lies between blocks number ninety five (95) and One hundred and fifteen (115) ninety six (96) and One hundred and fifteen (115) ninety seven (97) and One hundred and fourteen (114) and extending from D. Street West to G. Street, together with the alleys passing through and dividing the above mentioned Blocks. It is Ordered that E. H. Waugh James Brooks and Henry Adolph be and they are hereby appointed to meet on the fifth day of January 1874 and examine streets and alleys and report to this Board at its session on the seventh day of January 1874 whether in their opinion any injustice or inconvenience will be worked by the vacation of such streets and alleys, it is further Ordered that the County Clerk give in the name of the Board an order to said viewers to meet and examine said streets and alleys and report to the Board as required by law.
