

in favor of the establishment of said change of road and said report having been read at the October session of the board 1873 and laid over until the January session 1874 the report was again read and objections having been filed that legal notice of the presentation of the petition had not been given and the board being of the opinion that legal notice of the presentation of the petition was not given it is Ordered that said petition be dismissed without further proceedings and that the petitioners pay the costs and expenses that have been caused by their aforesaid application

In the matter of the petition
of C. Wulfskuhl and others
for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for a road as follows Beginning at the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section thirty three (33) Township twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18) Thence West on half Section lines as near as practicable one and one half miles to intersect a North and South road. And C. Wulfskuhl one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two Hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas with Theo. Packler surety conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law It is Ordered that A. A. Faxon, L. E. Ray and C. M. Bonner three disinterested householders of the county of Douglas be, and they hereby are appointed viewers and T. L. Darling surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the tenth day of February 1874 at ten o'clock A. M. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.
