

In the matter of the petition  
of C. B. Disbrow and others for  
the vacation of streets and alleys  
in the Town of Clinton

The viewers appointed by the  
Board in their order of January 2 1874 & examine said  
streets and alleys having reported that no injustice or  
inconvenience would result from the vacation of said  
streets and alleys, the report was read and no objections  
being made It is Ordered that said streets and alleys be  
and the same are hereby vacated to wit: so much of E.  
Street as lies between blocks number thirty five and thirty  
six thirty five (35) and thirty six (36) thirty five (35) and thirty six  
(36) eighty five (85) and eighty six (86) ninety five (95) and ninety  
six (96) One hundred and fifteen (115) and One hundred and  
sixteen (116), extending from Second Street to the South line  
of said town site, also so much of F Street as lies between  
blocks number fifty four (54) and fifty five (55) sixty six (66) and  
sixty seven (67) eighty four (84) and eighty five (85) ninety six (96)  
and ninety seven (97) One hundred and fourteen (114) and One hundred  
and fifteen (115) and extending from Second Street to the  
South line of said town site, also so much of Third Street  
as lies between blocks thirty five (35) and thirty six (36) thirty  
six (36) and thirty five (35) extending from D. Street West to  
G. Street, also so much of fourth Street as lies between blocks  
fifty four (54) and sixty seven (67) fifty five (55) and sixty six (66)  
thirty six (36) and thirty five (35) extending from D. Street West to  
G. Street, also so much of fifth Street as lies between sixty  
five (65) and eighty six (86) sixty six (66) and eighty five (85) sixty  
seven and eighty four (84) extending from D. Street West to G.  
Street, also so much of seventh Street as lies between blocks  
number ninety five (95) and One hundred and sixteen (116)  
ninety six (96) and One hundred and fifteen (115) ninety seven (97)  
and One hundred and fourteen (114) and extending from D. Street  
West to G. Street together with the alleys passing through  
and dividing said blocks.
