It is Ordered that the County Surveyor do and he is hereby directed to make an estimate of the cost of a bridge at said point and present the same to the Board of Commissioners.

In the matter of the petition of E. H. Vanhousen and others for the review of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the review of a road the route of which has become uncertain on account of the destruction of the records of the county clerk's Office viz: Beginning at the South East corner of Section 22 Township 15 Range 19 Thence North three and one half miles. Thence East one half mile Thence North one half mile. Thence one half mile Thence North Eighty (80) rods. and the board being satisfied that the true course of said road has become uncertain It is ordered that E. S. Scudder, B. H. Hammill and Matthew Gale three disinterested householders of the county of Douglas be and they are hereby appointed a committee of reviewers and F. C. Darling a Surveyor to review ^{said road} and that they meet on the 17th day of February 1874 at the home of E. H. Vanhousen at ten o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that said reviewers and Surveyor make report of their proceedings in the premises to this Board at its session in April 1874 It is further Ordered that the Board give to them the necessary order
