Ordered, that the County Clerk and he is hereby directed to advertise for proposals for Medical Attendance on patients at the County Poor farm and County jail for one year from the first day of May next, six insertions in the Republican Daily Journal and two in the Weekly Home Journal, proposals to be received till the 15th day of April A.D. 1874 at the Office of the County Clerk.

Ordered, that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to procure from the land Office or land Offices of the proper district or districts an abstract of all lands entered subsequent to the 1st day of January A.D. 1869.
