The following preamble and resolution presented by Commissioner S. L. Clark was on Motion adopted.

Whereas: There is an important suit pending between the County of Douglas and The Slavenworth Lawrence and Galveston Rail Road Company in which \$500,000.00 of bonds issued by the County to the said Company are involved, And

Whereas: It is expected that said suit will be tried at the April Term of the District Court for the County, And

Whereas: All official acts in connection with the issuing of said Bonds are important to said suit. Therefore,

Resolved: That the Commission appointed to examine the records and financial affairs of the County, are requested to report to this Board at as early a day as possible all the facts connected with the issuing of said bonds.
