The following proceedings were had.

Ordered, that S. J. Zimmerman be and he is hereby appointed as Agent of the County of Douglas in place of Joel Grover, to represent the County in any stockholders meeting of the St. Louis, Lawrence and Denver Railroad Company and to vote the stock of the County at any such meeting. And it is further Ordered that the County Clerk notify Joel Grover of the appointment of S. J. Zimmerman in his stead.

Vincent received 1945 votes for Senator and that Sidney Clarke received 19 votes for Senator and that there were scattering 24 votes for Senator and the said board caused a certified copy of the result to be filed in the County Clerks Office.
