

Lawrence April 13th 1874

The board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas met pursuant to law, there were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark and Zimmerman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had

The Commissioners record of proceedings from January 12th to the present date were read and on Motion approved.

In the Matter of the petition of
Wm McKinney for licence to run a ferry.

The said Wm McKinney having made application to run a ferry on the Kansas river at Secompton, and the board believing that such ferry is necessary for the accomodation of the public and that such ferry is so little used as not to justify the payment of licence. It is ordered that the County Clerk issue a licence to said McKinney without the payment of any tax, for one year from the first day of April 1874, with liberty to collect tolls at the following rates, for a two horse team forty (40) cents, for one horse & Buggy thirty (30) cents, for one horse and rider twenty (20) cents, for a horse, cattle, sheep & hogs, each ten (10) cents.

The Trustee of Endora Township, J. C. Darling, presented his Annual report which was examined with vouchers and approved. And it was ordered, that the sum of one dollar per week be allowed to Walter Harris, for the care of his son Fels Harris (an idiot) upon his presenting a bill duly certified by said Trustee.
