Lawrence Kansas April 14th 1874

The board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners J. Deskins, S. L. Clark and S. J. Zimmerman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

This being the day required by law for canvassing the votes of the several Township elections they proceeded to canvass the same, and caused a certified copy of the result to be filed in the County Clerk's Office.

The board adjourned until 2 O'Clock P.M.

The board met pursuant to adjournment at 2 O'Clock P.M. there were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark & Zimmerman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had.

The Trustees of Willow Springs, Wakarusa, Grant and Palmyra townships presented their Annual reports which were examined with vouchers and approved.

Ordered that the sum of ten (10) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General County fund for the relief of the daughter of J. C. Noecker payable to said Noecker on the order of the County Clerk & Chairman of the board.

Ordered that the County Clerk notify the several Township Assessors to meet on the third Wednesday of April the 15th inst as required by law at the Court house in Lawrence.

The board adjourned untill tomorrow morning April 15th 1874 at nine O'Clock.
