 The board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment these
 were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark & Zimmerman and the
 County Clerk J. B. Smith

The following proceedings were had:

In the Matter of Charles Parker
 Confined in the County jail

Ordered that said Parker may be delivered
 from custody upon his paying into the County Treasury the amount
 of the accrued costs in his case and presenting a receipt for the same
 to the County Clerk.

In the Matter of the petition of
 C. Wulf Kuhl & others for the
 establishment of a County road

The viewers having reported in favor of
 the establishment of said road, the report was this day publicly read
 and no objections being made and no damages claimed, the board
 being of opinion that the said road as laid out and surveyed will be
 of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat
 and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further
 ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the neces-
 sary order to the proper overseer of roads directing that said road
 be opened according to law.

In the Matter of the petition of
 C. H. Vanhoesen & others for the
 review of a County road.

The report of the viewers and reviewers be-
 ing in favor of the establishment of said road, the report was this
 day publicly read and no objections being made and no damages claim-
 ed, the board being of the opinion that the said road as laid out and
 surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the
 reviewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road
 be established. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the
 name of the board the necessary order to the proper overseer of roads
 directing that said road be opened according to law.

In the Matter of the petition of
 C. W. Flory & others for the
 establishment of a County road.

The said petitioners having made appli-
