Darling Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the place of beginning of said road designated in the petition on the 7th day of May 1874, at ten O'Clock A.M. and after being duly sworn proceed to <sup>the</sup> discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning on the north line of the North West quarter of Section seven (7) Township thirteen (13) range twenty (20), where Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence extended South would intersect said section line, thence running South as near as practicable to near the north bank of the Wakarusa river, thence across said river at the most practicable point, thence to the half section line between the east and west halves of Section nineteen (19) Township thirteen (13) range twenty (20) thence South on half section lines to the south line of Section seven (7) Township fourteen (14) range twenty (20) thence in a Southwesterly direction to intersect a road running South at or near the south west corner of Section eighteen (18) Township fourteen (14) range twenty (20). It is ordered that Oliver Barber, Wm Brass and E. A. Coleman three disinterested householders of the County be and they are hereby appointed viewers and J. C. Darling Surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning of said road designated in the petition on the fourth day of May 1874 at ten O'Clock A.M. and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.
