Pursuant to adjournment the board of County Commissioners met. There were present Commissioners Deskins Zimmerman and Clark and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had.

In the Matter of petition of
L. S. Steele in regard to Double
assessment on certain lots in Clinton

It appearing to the satisfaction of the board that the lots in Blocks. 76, 77, 78, 79, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108 & 109, were assessed as lots in 1864 & 1865 and sold as appears by the tax sale record for the taxes and costs thereon and that the same had been vacated by act of the Legislature and was the same years assessed as lands and the taxes thereon paid by the owner. It is therefore Ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to enter on the duplicate tax sale record that the sale of such lots were illegal and further that he notify the County Treasurer that he may make same entry on the original tax sale record

Ordered that Holland Wheeler be and he is hereby directed to examine and make estimate for building a bridge at the present crossing of the Wakarusa at the County poor farm & on the line on the West side of said farm

In the Matter of a petition of J. C. Metzler
and others for a bridge on the south line of
Section 31 T. 13. R. 19.

Ordered that an appropriation of two hundred dollars and the same is hereby made for the purpose of building said bridge over the creek crossing the road on said line and that C. Musselman Overseer of road district No 10 in Clinton Township be and he is hereby appointed a commissioner to advertise for proposals for building said bridge at the point
