

Lawrence Kansas April 18th 1874

The board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Deskins Clark, and Zimmerman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had

Ordered that the several Township Trustees of the County of Douglas be and they are hereby directed to remove all paupers within their respective townships to the County Asylum and to notify the County Clerk of such removals and it is further ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to notify the several Township Trustees that hereafter no accounts for provisions or Medical Attendance on poor will be allowed by the County Commissioners unless special arrangements are made with the County Commissioners for the ordering of said provisions and Medical Attendance.

Ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to keep a record of the names of all temporary paupers that may be brought to his notice from any source
