The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the Petition of A. K. Lowe
for a licence to run a ferry.

The said Lowe having made application to run a ferry on the Kansas river at a point in Douglas County within one mile and above the mouth of Coon Creek in the North west quarter of Section 34 in Township 11 Range 18. And the board believing that such ferry is necessary for the accommodation of the public. It is ordered that the Clerk issue a licence to the said A. K. Lowe upon his payment of ten dollars into the County treasury for one year from the first day of April 1874. with liberty to collect tolls at the following rates. For a two horse team forty (40) cents for one horse & buggy thirty (30) cents. for one horse & rider twenty (20) cents for horses, cattle, sheep & hogs each ten (10) cents.
