It was therefore ordered that James Joseph be and he is hereby appointed to the Office of Constable in and for said Township and that the County Clerk issue a certificate of said appointment to said Joseph.

John Speer submitted his report on said matter referred to him on 17th instant in which he finds that the total amount of overcharges in excess of undercharges to be eight hundred and seventy two and $49/100$ dollars. J. D. Thacher being present requested that he be permitted to take said report with the papers connected with the same to examine, and that further action in the matter be deferred until he have time to make such examination, which request was granted.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the board & Commissioners that E. S. Snow & wife of Palmyra Township are in destitute circumstances. It is ordered that the Trustee of said Township be and he is hereby authorized to expend for the temporary relief of said Snow and wife a sum not to exceed one dollar and fifty cents each per week.
