Ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to cause to
be made a duplicate of the tax rolls of the lands and the City of
Lawrence for the year 1874.

In the matter of settlement of differences
between Douglas County and J. D. Thacher
as to County printing and advertising

J. D. Thacher appeared and requested
that he be allowed further time to examine the report of John
Speers on said matter. On motion time was granted till to-
morrow morning.

The board adjourned until tomorrow morning
April 29th 1874.
