Contract for Printing

This Agreement made and entered into this sixth (6) day of May A. D. 1874 by and between the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and James T. Stevens of Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the promises and agreements of said party of the first part hereinafter mentioned, said party of the second part promises, undertakes and agrees to and with said party of the first part, to print, publish and circulate in a newspaper of said party of the second part and known as the "Spirit of Kansas" all tax lists of said party of the first part authorized or required by law to be published, at a price ninety five (95) per cent less than the price now allowed by the Laws of the State of Kansas for such work. Also to do all other legal advertising said party of the first part may want, need or require at seventy-five (75) per cent less than legal rates therefor. And in consideration thereof said party of first part promises and agrees to pay said party of second part for such work, the price hereinbefore mentioned for as much thereof as it may have, and the party of the second part shall do under this agreement.

This Contract to take effect and be in force from the date hereof to the 1st day of May A. D. 1875-
