

Lawrence, Wednesday, July 15th 1874

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment, at the County Clerk's office when there were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark, and Zimmerman, and the county clerk, J. B. Smith -

The following proceedings were had -

In the matter of the petition of Andrew Toole and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers appointed by the Board April 15th 1874, having made their report in favor of the establishment of said road, the report was publicly read, and there being remonstrances filed, and considered, against the establishment of the same, the Board postponed further consideration of the matter until the first Wednesday after the first Monday in September next

The Board went into session to consider matters relating to the equalization of the valuation of property in the County returned by the Assessors for taxation, and at 5 o'clock P.M. adjourned until tomorrow, July 16th, at 9 O'Clock P.M.
