In the matter of a petition
of Michael Wetherman and others
for the establishment of a Road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows: That a change be made in the County road established October 8th 1868, on the petition of Samuel Harbour and others as follows: Beginning on the half section line between the East and West halves of Section Six (6) Township fourteen (14) Range nineteen (19) 37 chains North of the S.E. corner of the West half of said section. Thence Change the portion of said road running northwesterly to the North East corner of the North West 1/4 of said section and locate the same on the half section line." And Michael Wetherman, one of the petitioners having filed his bond, in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said County, and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law. It is Ordered that George H. Evans, J. B. Baker and J. M. Scott, three disinterested householders of said County be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and T. C. Darling Surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of Beginning of said Change of road as designated in the petition, on the 23^d day of September A.D. 1874, at ten O'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the Clerk issue in the name of the Board, the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor.

The Board adjourned until July 27th 1874 at 10 O'clock A. M.
