

on the petition of C. H. Taylor, beginning at the corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23 of Township 12 Range 19, running thence West and North and across the lake, and if a growing hedge along or near the half section line running north in Section fifteen be found within the line of said road, that said line of road be changed so that the center of the road be located and established twenty (20) feet east from the hedge"; And Eben Baldwin, one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two Hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of Douglas County, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said County, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, it is therefore Ordered, that Joel Grover, W. Crutchfield, and George W. Goss, three disinterested householders of said County be, and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and T. C. Darling, Surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place designated in the petition as the beginning of said road, on the 7th day of September 1892 at ten O'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.

It is further ordered, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board, the necessary Order, to the Viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of E. Jones and others for the establishment of a certain road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road, "beginning at the north east corner of Section thirty five (35) Township thirteen (13) Range nineteen (19) thence west to north west corner of Section thirty four (34) thence south to the south line of Wakarusa Township on, or near the line as practicable"; And Edward Jones, one of the petitioners aforesaid having filed his Bond, in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of Douglass County, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said County,
