The petitioners having made application for "a Change to be made in the County road established in July 1868, on the petition of S. W. Mettler and others, as follows: Begin at the quarter section corner in the north line of section two (2) Town fourteen (14) Range Eighteen (18) thence running East on section line sixty (60) rods thence South and parallel with the East line of said section to a point a short distance north of the half section line, thence Southeast to a point about the same distance South of said half section line and eighty rods West of the East line of said section, thence South and parallel to said east line to intersection of the road as before established, and to vacate that portion of the old road as lies between the points of beginning and ending of such change; And J. C. Mettler one of the petitioners having filed his Bond, in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of Douglas County, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application, in case the prayer of said petitioners be not granted; And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been made as provided by law, it is therefore, Ordered, that W.
