B. Hecox, one of the petitioners having filed his bond, in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of Douglas County, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of said petitioners be not granted; And it appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve house-holders of the County, and that notice of the presentation of the petition was given as required by law, it is therefore Ordered that W. Baldwin, J. B. Deming, and Philip A. Simmons, three disinterested house-holders of the County be, and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and T. C. Darling Surveyor for said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning, as designated in the petition, on the 2nd day of September 1874, at 10 O'clock A.M., and after being duly sworn, proceed to discharge the duties of their several appointments, according to law. And it is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue, in the name of the Board, the necessary order to the Viewers and Surveyor
