

Lawrence Kansas July 29th 1874

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office, pursuant to adjournment there were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had

James E. Watson County Treasurer presented his annual report of receipts and disbursements of his office from July 12th 1873, to July 13th 1874, which was placed of file for examination by the Board.

In the matter of Assessment of the property of Lawrence Lumber and Water Power Company.

The County Clerk laid the matter before the Board, and it appearing that said property was not assessed and returned by the Assessor of the City of Lawrence, and the listing papers and affidavit of the proper officer of said Company being considered by the Board, it was Ordered that the property said Company be assessed at ten thousand (\$10,000) Dollars.

Upon the request, and with the concurrence of the township Trustees of the following named townships, the Board proceeded to make a levy for tax for township purposes as follows to wit: Oudorn township, Willow Springs township, Leecompton township, One mill on the dollar valuation of all taxable property in said townships, and in Palmyra township, ^{one mill} and Kanwaka township ~~and~~, two mills on the dollar valuation of all taxable property.

It was Ordered by the Board, that S. L. Clark be, and he is hereby authorized to sell at private sale, certain lots in Baldwin City, held by the County, by purchase at tax sale.
