Ordered by the Board, upon the request of the County Attorney, that John Scott be released from confinement in the County Jail

In the matter of the petition of Henry Baseman for a License to run a Ferry across the Kansas river at Eudora

Ordered by the Board that a license in conformity with said petition be issued to the said Henry Baseman, by the County Clerk, upon the payment into the Treasury, of the County, the sum of Two Dollars, license fee, as provided by law, and upon the approval of the Board of said Henry Baseman, according to law, he shall be at liberty to collect tolls at the following rates: For a two horse team forty (40) cents, for one horse & buggy thirty (30) cents, for one horse and rider twenty (20) cents, for horses,
