In the Matter of the Poor farm Bridge,
and repairs of the same being under
Consideration by the Board

Upon the request of the Board, M.
Lescher presented a report of the Condition, and an estimate
of the cost of repairs needed on the same, And also filed Specifi-
cations for the repair of the same.

Ordered that the County Clerk advertise according to law, for
proposals and bids for repairing the Poor Farm Bridge, in accordance
with specifications on file in the County Clerk's office

In the Matter of the petition
of Anthony Sells, Asking to be
Allowed to redeem certain
certain lands, being considered

Ordered by the Board, that, the following lands
sold for the taxes of A.D. 1862, - 63 + 64, to wit: Sections 13, + 14
in Town 12 of Range 17, and lot two (2) of Section 26, in
Town 11, of Range 17, (the certificate of the said sale belonging
to the County,) may be redeemed by the owner of said lands
upon payment to the County Treasurer, the amount of taxes and
costs due upon the same, and ten per cent interest on the
amount until date of redemption

Ordered, that an appropriation of Four hundred (400) Dollars,
be, and it is hereby made, from the General fund of the
County, to pay for repairs to be made on the Poor Farm Bridge,

Ordered, that William Meairs, trustee of Kalamazoo township
be, and he is hereby appointed a Commissioner to superin-
tend the repairs to be made on the Poor farm Bridge, in accor-
dance with specifications of the same, on file in the County
Clerk's office

In the Matter of the
