The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, met at the office of the County Clerk, pursuant to adjournment there were present, Commissioners Derkins, Zimmerman and Clark, and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith

The following proceedings were had-

In the matter of the Petition
of A. Tosh, and others for
the establishment of a road,

The viewers appointed April 1st 1874 as appears on page 267 of this record, having made their report in favor of the establishment of said road, and said report was read before the Board, when there being a remonstrance against the same filed by William Miller, on motion, further consideration of the subject was postponed until the October Meeting of the Board -

The Board took a recess until Monday September 14th 1874, at One O'clock P.M.
