tion on the same be postponed for the present, and that the
Board will visit and examine the location of said road

for the establishment of a road,

The Board had the matter under con-
sideration, when on motion, any action on the same was
postponed until some future time -

In the matter of the petition
of L. R. Hecox and others, for
the establishment of a road

The Board had the same under
consideration, when on motion, it was resolved to take
the whole subject under advisement, and that further
action on the same be postponed until the first Wednes-
day after the first Monday in January next

In the matter of the petition
of E. Baldwin and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers appointed by the Board
at the July session, as appears on pages 300, & 301. of this record
having made their report in favor of the location and estab-
lishment of said road, and in favor of allowing to W.
H. Peace the sum of Twenty dollars damages, claimed, and
said report having been publicly read, and fully con-
sidered, and the Board being of the opinion that the
said road as laid out and ~~surveyed~~ will be of public
utility, it is therefore Ordered by the Board, that the re-
ports of the viewers, and the plot and survey be recorded
and that said road be established, and said claim
