

of twenty dollars, for damages to W. H. Pease be allowed as compensation of land taken from the west half of the South East quarter of section number fifteen (15) town twelve (12) range nineteen (19) for said road, in the sum of Twenty five (25) dollars. And also, that said W. H. Pease be permitted to leave a ~~hedge~~ fence now standing upon the line of said located road, until a hedge fence can be grown on the line of his remaining land adjoining thereto. And it is further Ordered, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board, the necessary order directing that said road be opened according to law.
