Lawrence Kansas Monday, October 19th 1874

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met at the office of the County Clerk, pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Dealman, Ginninerman & Clark and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had,

J. C. Darling, township trustee of Endorn township appeared before the Board, and reported (verbally), that at a meeting of the people of Endorn township, held October 15th 1874, the people of said township there assembled voted to request the County Commissioners not to levy any tax to pay interest accruing on Bonds of said Township issued to Rural Road Companies. It was thereupon Ordered by the Board that no levy of tax be made for the payment of interest on said Bonds accruing AD 1874.

The Board had under consideration, the matter of adding of certain Bonds and Mortgages to the Assessment roll, that it was found had not been listed by persons holding the same, and which are subject to taxation, the parties being notified according to law, and testimony taken, relating thereto.
